SATURDAY COMPETITION: Single entries welcome, *OR* you may be part of the TEAM CHALLENGE. Teams must consist of three horse/rider combinations. No horse or rider can ride twice for the same team; no combination can compete on two teams; no more than two FEI combinations per team; no more than one professional rider per team. Team riders may compete at any level. Single team members are also allowed to ride at different levels. The lowest single score of the team will be dropped. The remaining scores will be handicapped according to the scale listed below the class listing, and averaged to obtain a team score. Scratches or eliminations for any reason will be considered a zero score and counted as either the low drop score for the team, or handicapped and computed into the team average score if more than one scratch/elimination occurs on a team.

SUNDAY CHAMPIONSHIPS: Open to all riders, with one qualifying score from any USEF-recognized show from the current show season as follows: Youth Training*: 58% or higher; Training & First Level- 60% or higher; Second thru Fourth Level- 58% or higher, FEI- 56% or higher. Copy of qualifying test must be submitted with entry, and must not be from an Opportunity class. The highest test at each level will be your test for the "Championship" class. As many classes as possible will be co-judged (two judges). Classes may be combined or split depending on entries. Tests must be ridden from memory and whips are allowed. Championship classes are to test the rider's skill and the horse's training, therefore ONLY THE QUALIFIED RIDER MAY RIDE THE QUALIFIED HORSE ON CHAMPIONSHIP DAY (except for a groom on a long rein). Note: Rides from prior year CSDEA Festival do not fall within the current show season. Musical Freestyle: First level and above, please designate level on entry and submit a qualifying freestyle test copy with entry. Qualifying score requirements same as above. *Youth Training Championship: Riders under 15 years of age at January 1 of the current year may compete in their own Youth Training Championship.

Footing: Main performance arenas are sand, standard size. If necessary, a third grass ring of standard size may be used. Warm up areas are sand and grass. **Other information:** Many vendors will be on grounds. Food is available on grounds. **All dogs must be leashed.**

Entries: Saturday second level and below are \$35 per ride. Third-Fourth-FEI-Freestyles are \$40 per ride. Saturday Quadrille riders are \$10 per rider. GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes please add \$15 to class entry fee. Each Team also pays \$30 for Team Sponsorship, please provide team name on each entry. Sponsor money goes into a "pay back pot"; winning team will get 60%, second place 25%, third place 15%. Sunday championship entry fee is \$48 per ride for all levels; Sunday Quadrille rides are \$20 per rider. Pas de Deux riders are \$25 per rider. Classes may be combined or split depending on entries.

ENTRIES: \$25 Office Fee per entry (online) or \$30 Office Fee (mailed) includes \$1 admission. \$20 Late entry or change of horse and/or rider after closing date. Post entries accepted if scheduling allows with \$5 post-entry fee per class. Enter online via www.HorseShowOffice.com or draw checks to "CSDEA" and mail entries to CSDEA Festival, P.O. Box 248, Dexter, MI 48130. Sorry, no credit cards for paper entries. Entries will not be accepted without payment. All applicable memberships or non-member fees required for riders, owners, horses, trainers, etc and applicable ID numbers for USDF/USEF must be included on entry. Horses not entered in the competition not allowed on grounds. **COGGINS:** Negative Coggins required in the horse's SHOW NAME from current show year. Please include copy with entry. **REFUNDS:** Full refund minus office fee prior to Closing Date. *After published closing date – no refunds for any reason*, even if closing date is extended. TIMES: Unofficial ride times will be posted 72 hours before the show at www.HorseShowOffice.com. Check show program at the grounds for official ride times.

STABLING: Stabling is mandatory (no jump-outs). Permanent 10x10 stalls with doors, on show grounds. Original bedding (1 bag) provided; additional may be ordered on entry for \$8 per bag, available on show grounds while supplies last. Indoor Stalls are \$80 for weekend, \$50 per day or overnight (6pm-6pm). Stalls on the exterior of the barn are \$60 for the weekend or \$40 per day or overnight, and may be assigned according to stall availability. Indicate stallions on entry form. Tack stalls \$75. Please plan your arrival – stabling will be available **AFTER 3PM** on the day before the show. Early arrivals may be subject to a \$30 penalty per horse and require advance permission.

AWARDS: Saturday: *Hays Companies* will award a trophy to each member of the winning team. Sunday: *Great American Insurance Co.* will provide an award for each Championship and Freestyle Class where a minimum score of 57% is achieved by the winning rider. A custom dressage or jumping saddle valued between \$2800-\$3100 will be awarded to the highest scoring individual CHAMPIONSHIP rider (Freestyle, Quadrille, Pas de Deux ride scores are not included) on Sunday, courtesy of *Saddlefitter.com* (score handicapping is shown following class list). Ribbons through sixth place awarded for all classes.

In order to honor our sponsors, presence at the Awards Ceremony is mandatory for all Championship class winners. We request you be in formal attire and mounted or forfeit first/second place award. Awards presentation will be at morning & afternoon breaks, lunch, and at the end of the day.

CLASSES MAY BE SEPARATED BY DIVISION AT MANAGEMENT DISCRETION PROVIDING SEPARATED DIVISIONS ALL HAVE AT LEAST 3 ENTRIES.
