Flat warm up will be allowed prior to the first class.

COURSE SET & SCHOOLING BREAK FOR WALK/TROT RIDERS & HORSES ONLY.

- 7 Trot Over Marked Course Equitation To be shown at a walk & trot over a course of poles on the ground simulating a jumping course. Open to Beginner riders.
- 8 Tiny X's Equitation To be shown at a walk & trot controlled canter allowed. Open to Beginner Riders.

 Others may enter as a courtesy round. **Middle of X about 6**"
- 9 Tiny X's Equitation To be shown at a walk & trot- controlled canter allowed. Open to Beginner Riders.
 Others may enter as a courtesy round. **Middle of X about 12**"
- 10 Mini Equitation To be shown at a trot controlled canter allowed. Open to Beginner Riders.

Others may enter as a courtesy round. Fences: vertical rail with ground line rail. Height 1'6" [No flower boxes]

11 Mini Hunter – To be shown at a trot – controlled canter allowed. Open to Green Horse and/or Beginner Rider.

Fences: vertical rail with ground line rail. Height 1'6" [No flower boxes]

12 Mini Equitation – To be shown at a trot – controlled canter allowed. Open to Beginner Riders.

Others may enter as a courtesy round. Fences: vertical rail with flower box. Height 2'

13 Mini Hunter – To be shown at a trot – controlled canter allowed. Open to Green Horse and/or Beginner Rider.

Fences: vertical rail with flower boxes. Height 2'

- 14 Very Low Hunter 2'3" (no oxers)
- 15 Very Low Hunter 2'3" (no oxers)
- 16 Beginner Equitation 2'3" (no oxers)
- 17 Low Hunter -2'3" 2'6" (w/oxers) [can be raised upon request]
- 18 Low Hunter 2'3" 2'6" (w/oxers) [can be raised upon request]
- 19 Open Equitation 2'3" 2'6" (w/oxers) [can be raised upon request]
