Entries: \$ 75 per round. Two consecutive levels may be ridden only if time and entries allow.

Entries may be limited to 50-60 rides. No refunds after closing date unless spot can be filled.

Stabling: Limited day stalls (\$20) and one paddock (\$50) for two or compatible horses—first reserved or farthest traveled gets them. Call to inquire. Checks for Stalls made to "Ginger Cantor".

<u>Attire/Safety:</u> All competitors **MUST** wear an approved and fastened ASTM/SEI helmet and footwear with heels when mounted. Cross country safety vests and medical armbands strongly recommended.

Food: Plan ahead to bring your own. Light refreshments may be provided at the show.

Facilities: Portable Toilets provided; hoses available for horse rinsing.

<u>Weather:</u> The show will be held unless lightning or unsafe footing is evident (too much rain prior to show). Organizer reserves right to revise course to keep competition safe if weather dictates.

<u>Trailering</u>: Please trailer with a buddy if possible. Trailer parking area is west end of farm, dip troughs will be provided.

<u>Times:</u> Ride times will be e-mailed to all competitors 48 hours before the show. Please include a legible e-mail address with entry.

<u>Description:</u> This schooling show is a combined test on steroids: It consists of a dressage test and a hunter derby, such that jumping phase will consist of both stadium and cross-country jumps. Scoring will follow USEA rules for jumping and dressage.

Dressage Phase: Will be based on USDF (Starter) and USEA (BN & Novice divisions) Dressage Tests. See links below. All Dressage Tests will be run first, then jumping will begin.

Dressage Phase will be held in an indoor arena.

Jumping Phase: Warmup will be held at completion of dressage phase. Stadium course includes verticals, flower/brush boxes, oxers, and cross rails. Cross-country course jumps are on grass terrain, and may include those appropriate for level, natural and solid jumps (logs, barrels, coop, corner, cabins, fly, chevrons, ditches, banks and a friendly 70*70-foot water complex).

Awards: Prizes for first place in each division. Ribbons through 6th place.

<u>Divisions</u>: Starter, Beginner Novice and Novice (junior and senior)

- 1) 17 years and under, Starter, Stadium and XC fences are 12"-2'3"
- 2) 18 years and up, Starter, Stadium and XC fences are 12"-2'3"
- 3) 17 years and under, Beginner Novice, Stadium and XC fences max 2'7"
- 4) 18 years and up, Beginner Novice, Stadium and XC fences max 2'7"
- 5) 17 years and under, Novice, Stadium and XC fences max 2'11"
- 6) 18 years and up, Novice, Stadium and XC fences max 2'11"
