- 5) Check made out to CSDEA
- 6) No dogs please, unless approved in advance, and then they must be leased at all times.
- 7) NO SMOKING on the grounds.

## Stabling:

- Limited day stalls (\$20 each) call to reserve.
- One day/overnight paddock suitable for up to 4 compatible horses (\$25 each). No overnight stalls.
- Checks for Stalls made to "Ginger Cantor".

**Facility:** Consists of full cross-country courses for starter, beginner novice and novice, including bank, water, ditches, with terrain and trails. Outdoor sand/limestone arena 100\*200, indoor sand/limestone arena 80\*180; Groom and wash stall.

<u>Attire:</u> All riders **MUST** wear an approved and fastened ASTM/SEI helmet and footwear with heels when mounted. THIS IS TRUE FOR ALL RIDERS, EVEN TRAIL OR DRESSAGE RIDERS.

Cross country safety vests and medical armbands strongly recommended when jumping.

**Trailering:** Please trailer with a buddy if possible. Trailer parking area is west end of farm, water and wash stalls available.
